Designated Members participate in a continuing education program. Currently, the Appraisal Institute confers the MAI and the SRA designations. Some members also may hold the SRPA designation.



MAI: Members holding this designation are experienced in the valuation and consultancy of commercial, industrial, residential and other property types, and advise clients on investment decisions.



SRPA: This designation is held by members experienced in the valuation and consultancy of commercial, industrial, residential and other property types.



SRA: This designation is held by members experienced in the valuation of residential real property.
